

Classroom Expectations



The most important thing we ask is that you follow your **A B C...**

A

Keep **A** safe distance. From staff and from each other.

Social Distancing

- You must follow social distancing rules when moving around the school and in the classroom.
- You must remain 2 metres apart.
- You must follow the signs in school.
- You are **not** allowed to walk around a classroom; you must stay in your designated seat unless the teacher requests for you to move.
- You must not share anything with others; this includes stationary, work booklets, food and drink.

B

Be clean and hygienic. Wash your hands, don't touch your face, cough and sneeze into your elbow – or a tissue you then throw away.

Hygiene

- You will be expected to access the toilet during break and lunch time. Numbers will be limited to two people in the toilet area at any time.
- You should wash your hands before and after going to the toilet.
- You must wash your hands regularly or use hand sanitiser.

Clothing and Equipment

- Your bags will remain in the classroom as much as possible unless there is a change of teaching location.
- You must not refill your water bottles school. Water will be available to purchase from the canteen.

C

Continue learning. Inside the classroom and out. That's what we're here to do!

Behaviour

- You must not physically touch another pupil or a member of staff.
- You must **NOT** spit, cough or sneeze purposely at other pupils or staff.
- You must not access any area of the school beyond your allocated spaces.
- You must be kind and respectful to all pupils and staff.
- You can discuss your worries and fears with an appropriate member of staff.

Illness

You must tell a member of staff if you feel unwell during the school day.
