Establishment of a permanent Governing Body
Parent Governor Nominations

The process has begun to establish a permanent governing body for the new school. I am writing to inform you that there is **ONE** vacancy for parent governor on the permanent governing body and nominations are now being sought.

This is an exciting opportunity to be part of a new governing body created for the new school. The role of the governing body is to set and oversee the strategic direction of the school; determine the aims, policies and priorities and to promote high standards of educational achievement and behaviour amongst its pupils. A governing body is made up of various categories of governor such as parent, community representative, teacher, support staff, and local authority appointed; all of whom come together for the sole purpose of ensuring the success of the pupils of the school.

An application form and list of the eligibility criteria is enclosed for your attention.

In general, any parent of a registered pupil at the school by the closing date of the nomination process is eligible to stand to be a parent governor. However, individuals may not be a member of more than two governing bodies at the same time.

If you are interested in one of these six positions, please complete the form in full and return it in a sealed envelope marked 'Parent Governor Nomination' to the main school reception. Do not include additional or supplementary pages with your nomination and only complete the form itself.
