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Celebration of Learning

Our children have loved inviting you to school to celebrate their learning with them. There's been many different events the last few weeks, from our nursery and reception farmers market to the year 5 'paint along' sessions! Thank you for your support. Below is a summary of some of the recent learning that has taken place:

Nursery & Reception- Farmers Market - Our inquiry this term was all about nature and how it helps us. We learned about life cycles and watched chrysalis change to butterflies and rescued some tadpoles then rehomed them in the school pond.. We used different skills to make items for our Farmers Market. We shared everything that nature had taught us in our Farmers Market.

Year 1- Selling of personal cookbooks!- This term, the children in Year 1 have been working incredibly hard to answer the big question, "How do we depend on the planet for survival?" Through this exploration, they have created their very own personal cookbooks! Children have learned various cooking techniques, discovered where our food comes from, and understood the importance of caring for our planet to ensure it can continue to care for us.

Year 2- Games Nights - Our end of inquiry product was a game using recycled materials. Pupils had studied the properties of materials, designed the games using their knowledge of recycled materials, prototyped, tested and innovated to create their finished product. Pupils also wrote instructions on how to play the game and a report about their chosen game. Year 2 voted on snacks that they would like to have at a Games Night for families, and raised money for these through selling bracelets also made from recycled materials. Families had a great evening and voted for the winning game – The Throwing Game!

Year 3- Designing Futuristic Products- This term the children in year 3 have been working hard to answer our big question 'how technology can positively impact our community'. Children have learnt the importance of technology and how it can benefit their communities to improve issues they see day to day. I am super proud of how well the children have engaged within our inquiry and worked hard together to create their technology.

Year 4- Hedgehog houses & Bug Hotels- Children have been learning all about how living things are connected in our environment and how to care for living things. They've been hard at work building bird boxes, hedgehog houses and bug hotels to increase living things in our school community.

Year 5- Paint Along Session - This term year 5 have been answering the inquiry question "can art change the world?" They have learned to use the mediums of pencils, paint and pastels to show the different art techniques in the world in 2024. They have learned all about the different periods of art and the diverse artists we have in our world and what makes each of them unique. The class held their own art gallery and an interactive art session with their families.
