Attendance

Wales National Assessments- Year 2 to Year 6

Pupils from year 2 to year 6 undergo yearly national testing in the summer term. These assessments have been in place for a number of years. They assess pupils' ability to read and understand; to perform mathematical procedures and to reason mathematically. There are 3 assessments in total.

Teachers and senior leaders facilitate them within the school in a comfortable and relaxed environment for the children.

The assessments are carried out online and are personalised, meaning they adapt depending on how each child is responding to the questions. These will take place in school after half term.



Meet your teacher! Primary transition days

Our transition days in primary are organised for the 11th and 12th of July 2024.

Children will move up to the next class to meet their teacher for the next academic school year. They will spend two mornings exploring their new learning environment and getting to know their next teacher.

Morning nursery - On these transition mornings children currently in morning nursery will have lunch in our school hall and can be collected at 12:30pm. This is to help prepare them for what to expect when they start full time reception in September.

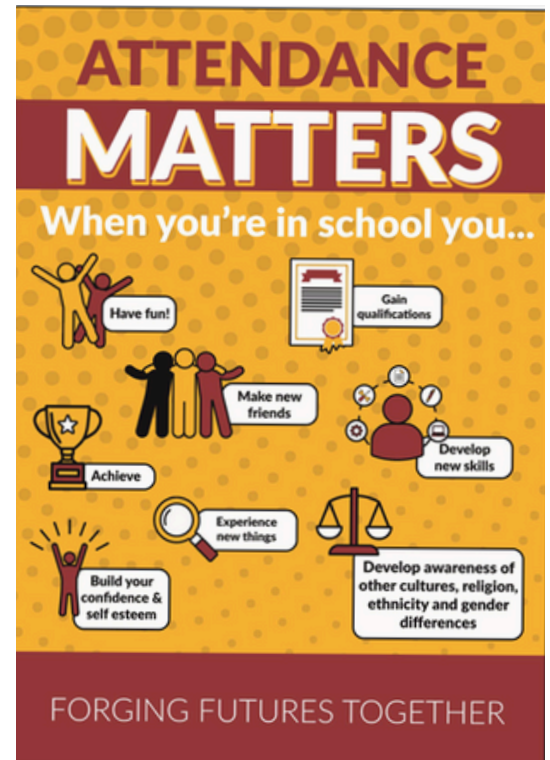
Primary Phase Garden

Should the weather be against us our back up date is 15th July.

11th & 12th July- 'Meet your teacher!'- An opportunity for our primary phase children to meet and spend the mornings with their teacher for the next academic year.
